

How to File a Complaint or Emergencies

To report an incident or emergency use the following contact information:

When filing a complaint provide the time, location, and specific details of what you are observing (hear, smell, see, and feel). Taking pictures and/or video with a time and date stamp will help the investigation.

If you observe a pollution incident involving streams or rivers make sure to tell the inspector that it is an emergency and immediate investigation is needed. *Contaminates will dissipate quickly in flowing waters and make it difficult for the inspector to collect a sample.*
